What the Workshop will cover:

Camera Basics

Get off auto and learn the basics of shooting in manual. Whether you are a complete beginner or someone who would like to be inspired to pick up your camera again, this basics overview will give you the confidence to begin shooting in manual and take control of your photography.

The Art of Seeing

Be reminded of the beautiful art of seeing as we look at the rules of composition, the magic of light and changing the way you see.

Finally we will have an overview of my basic editing workflow in Lightroom.

Learning into practice and Creative Play The final stage of the workshop will involve some creative play and the opportunity to put some learning into practice with a selection of shooting bays in the studio. Finally we will do a golden hour autumn photo walk in Jubilee Park.

Frequently asked questions

Where is the workshop located?

At Lara's studio and workshop space in her My Notes From Gallery, Studio, & Store in Tenterfield. We will also do a guided photo walk to finish the day in Jubilee Park.

What do we need to bring?

You will receive your workshop booklet on arrival so you can take notes on that. I will have pens here as well. As the workshop involves an element of creative play in the studio you will need to bring your camera.

Who is the workshop for and what experience do we need?

The workshop is aimed for beginner photographers or those who would like to refresh their skills. Participants will need to have a basic understanding of their cameras, how to turn on manual mode and how to move from one setting to the next. For those who need assistance with camera familiarisation, there is an hour allocated for this before the workshop starts.

Is this workshop suitable for phone cameras?

No. Whilst phone cameras are fabulous I am old-fashioned and don't use my phone camera. This workshop is definitely designed for those with cameras that can be switched from Automatic to Manual Mode.

Will any food and beverages be provided?

Yes, a working lunch and afternoon tea will be provided.

Will the workshop involve any practical elements or is it all theory?

The latter part of the workshop will involve what I call time for creative play. I will have several shooting areas set up in the studio and you will have access to different chairs, apple boxes and stools for posing. I will be on hand to assist with settings, composition, lighting and any questions you might have. We will also have a guided photo walk in Jubilee Park to finish the day.

How many people will be at the workshop?

The workshop is limited to 5 people so that every body can get the attention they need.
